2. Subject of the Declaration

This declaration applies to plastic packaging manufactured by WEHA Plastic GmbH, *including plastic reels, plastic flanges, plastic cores and related spacers manufactured from polystyrene (PS)*.

Upon request, this declaration may be supplemented by a customer-specific list of articles.

3. Declaration

WEHA Plastic GmbH declares under its sole responsibility that the above-mentioned packaging complies with the applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste (PPWR). The conformity assessment procedure required by Article 38 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 has been carried out.

This EU Declaration of Conformity has been drawn up in accordance with Article 39 and Annex VIII of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

4. Compliance with PPWR Requirements

Article 5 – Requirements for substances in packaging

The sum of the concentrations of

- lead
- cadmium
- mercury
- hexavalent chromium

does not exceed 100 mg/kg.

Article 7 – Recyclability

The packaging consists of mono-material polystyrene (PS) and is suitable for mechanical recycling.

Article 8 – Recycled content

The packaging contains mechanically recycled material.

The typical recycled content is approximately **85%**.

Article 10 – Minimisation

Packaging weight and volume have been reduced to the minimum necessary while maintaining the intended technical function.

Article 11 – Packaging characteristics

Material	Polystyrene (PS)
Construction	Mono-material construction

Article 15 – Labelling

The packaging is marked in accordance with the applicable labelling requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

Where future implementing legislation requires additional digital marking (e.g. QR codes), such requirements will be implemented within the applicable statutory transition periods.

5. PFAS

To the best of our current knowledge, no PFAS substances are intentionally added during the manufacture of the above-mentioned packaging.

6. Reuse

The plastic reels are designed for multiple industrial reuse applications.

7. Technical Documentation

The technical documentation required under Regulation (EU) 2025/40 is maintained by WEHA Plastic GmbH in accordance with the applicable legal requirements.

It will be made available to the competent market surveillance authorities upon justified request.

8. Changes

Any changes to products, materials or manufacturing processes affecting the conformity of this declaration will be communicated to affected customers without undue delay.

Legal status notice

This Declaration of Conformity has been prepared on the basis of the legal requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 applicable at the date of issue. Should future delegated or implementing acts introduce additional requirements, this declaration will be updated accordingly.
